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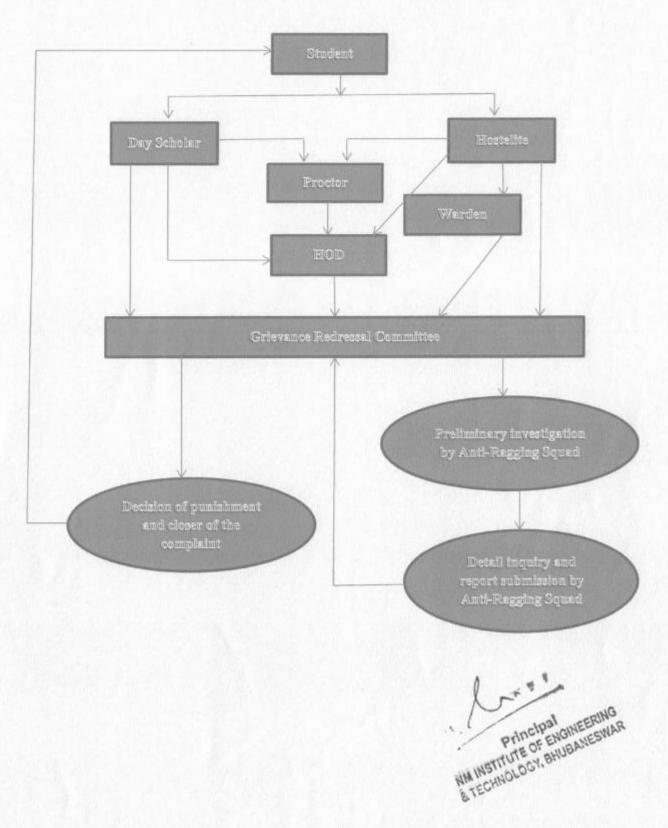

To prevent the menace of ragging and maintain healthy interpersonal relations among students in the college campus of NM Institute of Engineering & Technology, Bhubaneswar ragging is strictly forbidden in or outside the college campus. For this Purpose the Anti-Ragging Committee has been implemented. So all are advised to actively take efforts to maintain the calm and quite environment in college campus. The Anti-ragging committee will be formed for this academic year 2021-22.

Following are The Anti-Ragging Policy which was formed earlier as given below for the reference.

Objectives of Anti Ragging Committee:

The Anti-Ragging Committee will be the supervisory and advisory committee in preserving a culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus. The student volunteers will work under the supervision of Anti Ragging committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation. The Anti-Ragging committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plans for curbing the menace of ragging in the college by adopting an array of activities.

Responsibilities of Anti Ragging Committee:

- To keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any, happening / reported in the places of student aggregation including, classrooms, canteen, grounds, lawns etc.
- Mandated Orientation Programme for freshers and parents to familiarize them with the institutional rules and regulations inclusive of anti-ragging measures, what constitutes ragging and the consequences to be faced.
- Prepare freshers not to oblige to such practices if at all they face any but to report boldly.

- As a preventive measure a member of the committee is appointed during the admission procedure throughout.
- Regular policing by the committee members and student's volunteers in the beginning of the odd semester every year.
- · To educate the students by adopting various means about the menace of ragging and related punishments there too.
- Assurance to maintain their confidentiality if reported.
- Make discrete random surveys.

As per the guidelines of UGC and BPUT, ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

- Display of noisy, disorderly conduct, teasing, excitement by rough or rude treatment.
- Handling, including rowdy, undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance.
- · Undue hardship, physical or psychological harms or raises apprehensive fear in a fresher.
- · Asking the students to do any act or perform something which any student would not do in the ordinary course and which causes him/her shame or embarrassment or danger to his/her life, etc.

Punishment for Participation in/or Abetment of Ragging:

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- 4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- 8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.

Initiatives to prevent the menace of ragging:

· Put up posters on Anti ragging on notice boards and at various vantage points in the college campus. NM INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY BHUBANESWAR

- Anti-Ragging complaint box will be installed at various places in the college so that students can freely and fearlessly contact the committee.
- Various competitions like essay writing, slogan writing, extempore and poster making on themes/topics related to ragging and anti-ragging will be organized to create awareness among students and sensitize the young minds on various aspects of ragging.
- Anti-ragging campaign/rallies will be organized within and outside the college campus to generate awareness. Enthusiastic students usually participate in these campaign rallies with charts, posters and boards with anti-ragging slogans written on them.
- Keeping in mind the present scenario to maintain and follow social distancing norms webinars will be organized (instead of seminar) to educate the students about various aspects of ragging and how it can be completely eradicated.

Anti-Ragging Policy:

Anti-Ragging policy shall strictly implement in this institution. Based on the Guidelines of the UGC and the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, all the steps and precautions to prevent ragging is to be effected in our institutions.

Any student studying or seeking admission should not involve or indulge in any sort of ragging in the campus, hostels or elsewhere. Ragging in any manner is a criminal offense and strictly policed & prohibited. Students found guilty of involving in ragging will be subjected to severe punishment as offence under IPC leading to expulsion from the institute without any notice. The course of action for the students proven guilty in ragging will be as per the rules and regulations on prevention of ragging imposed from time to time by the Government / Apex Courts or any other competent authorities.

Future Plans:

 Arrange for professional counseling sessions to prevent any untoward incidents to both seniors and freshers.

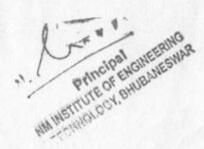

As per law, it is mandatory for every workplace to have an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) that would a critical role in prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment at the work place.



ICC has a responsibility to establish an effective internal complaints procedure, where:

- Assurance that no victimization will result from making a complaint.
- Procedure is well documented, available and in accessible formats.
- Members who manage complaints are well trained.
- Assistance is provided in the form of language interpreters as needed for parties to a complaint.
- Ensuring the process is confidential, independent and based on principles of natural justice.
- Ensuring the process has clear timelines.
- · All conflicts of interest are managed appropriately.

On receipt of a complaint ICC shall conduct preliminary enquiry so as to ascertain the truth of the allegations by collecting the documentary evidence as well as recording statements of any possible witnesses including the complainant. ICC shall then submit the preliminary enquiry report to Convener/Disciplinary authority along with all the original documents adduced during the preliminary enquiry proceedings. In case the allegations are not in the nature of sexual harassment, ICC may refer such complaints to the Grievance Redressal Cell or to Registrar.

Where sexual harassment occurs as a result of an act or omission by any third party or outsider, ICC shall take all steps necessary and reasonable to assist the affected person in terms of support and preventive action.

ICC shall comply with the procedure prescribed in the aforementioned UGC Regulations 2015 and the Sexual Harassment Act for inquiring into the complaint in a time bound manner.

If ICC concludes that the allegations made were false, malicious or the complaint was made knowing it is to be untrue or forged or misleading information has been provided during the enquiry, the complaint ant shall be liable to be punished as per the relevant provision of the aforementioned UGC Regulations 2015.

Member Secretary/ Chairperson, ICC shall receive the complaints of Sexual Harassment, if any, on behalf of ICC and shall co-ordinate the deliberations of the ICC on the complaints received.

Who can approach to ICC for help?

Any female employee (Faculty, Students or Staff) of NMIET, Bhubaneswar.

Definition of Sexual Harassment:

"Sexual Harassment" includes any unwelcome sexually inclined behavior, whether directly or indirectly such as:

- · Physical contact and advances.
- Demand or request for sexual favors.
- Sexually colored remarks.
- Showing any pornography, or
- Any other unwelcome physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature.

sexual nature.

Possible actions that can be taken against the respondent:

- · Warning.
- · Written apology.
- Bond of good behavior.
- · Adverse remark in the Confidential Report.
- · Stopping of increments/promotion.
- Suspension.
- Dismissal.
- · Any other relevant actions.

Inquiry Process:

- The enquiry shall be completed within a period of seven days from the date of the complaint.
- On completion of the enquiry, the ICC shall provide a report of its findings to the employer within a period of ten days from the date of completion of the enquiry and such report be made available to the concerned parties.
- If the allegations against the respondent have been proved, it shall recommend punitive
 actions to be taken against the respondent to the employer.
- . The employer shall act upon the recommendation within 15 days of receiving it.

Frequency of Meeting:

According to the regulations framed by AICTE, the Committee meets at least two times in a year and the decisions arrived at is mandatory to be implemented. The Committee functions under the Chairmanship of the Committee

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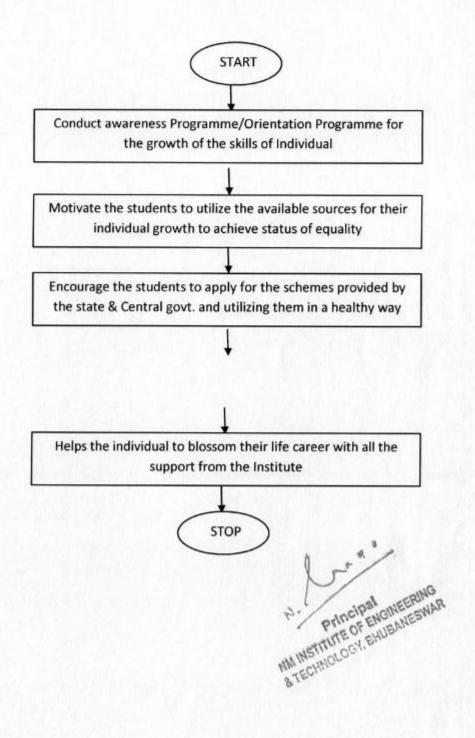
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MINORITY CELL SOP-FLOW CHART
